- Tour of Fort Mackinac – where history comes alive! Constructed by British soldiers during the American Revolution, the fort served as a sentinel in the Straits of Mackinac for 115 years. Trace the footsteps of British and American troops as you explore 14 original 18th and 19th century buildings, enjoy informative and interactive exhibits, and watch our 1880s soldiers play concerts of military music, fire rifles on the parade ground and a cannon salute over the harbor.
